CALL TO ORDER

Land Use

Barbara Ray and Howard Greif provided an overview what OTACA was attempting to accomplish. This committee will continue to stay involved with OTCAC

Other Issues

A request was made to identify the method in which MCPS works to change school district boundaries. Discussion was had on the number of people that should be on the committee, should it be limited.

Concern was raised as to who the makeup of the debate committee – should participants who currently work for elected officials, were either elected officals or ran for office in the past 2 years be eligible?
