Montgomery Parks has recently posted notification of an upcoming closure of the southern entrance into Olney Manor Recreational Park. The public's concern about the decision has resulted in Montgomery Parks coordinating a forum to better summarize the matter and allow the neighbors to voice their concerns. Following up on the community request, Montgomery Parks has announced a community meeting to review the decision and allow public comments. Please note that the above time is a revised (later) starting time than was originally planned the Montgomery County Parks.

Metro's "SafeTrack "

During Metro's 10-month system-wide SafeTrack project, three planned "safety surge" line segment repairs and around-the-clock single tracking projects will affect Metrorail Red Line service in Montgomery County: August 1-7 (Takoma to Silver Spring), August 9-18 (Shady Grove to Twinbrook), and October 10 - November 1 (Fort Totten to NoMa). Here's what Montgomery County is doing to help travelers:

- Promoting telework and transportation alternatives
- Providing [supplemental Ride On bus service](#) and free shuttles between Metrorail stations See http://www2.montgomerycountymd.gov/mcgportalapps/Press_Detail.aspx?Item_ID=14112
- Enhancing management center operations to improve traffic flow
- Using on-street parking restrictions, as needed, to improve traffic flow
