Registered voters who want to vote by mail may request an application online to vote in the Presidential General Election as long as they have a Maryland driver's license or MVA-issued ID card. If you request a vote by mail ballot, it will be your official ballot and you will not be able to vote on the paper based, digital image scan voting system at the polls on Election Day on November 8, or during Early Voting, October 27 - November 3.
