PRESIDENT's REPORT

Matching Funds Available for Neighborhood Events

The Neighborhood Events Matching Fund was established by Montgomery County to encourage capacity building, networking and to stimulate the local economy. Maximum grant amount is \$1,000. Funds must be matched and the event must take place this Fiscal Year - by June 30, 2018. To apply contact your Regional Services Area Director at 240-777-8101. There is no deadline for application, but funding is limited.

Relocation of Mid-County Regional Service Office

The Mid-County Regional Service Office will permanently relocate to the new Wheaton Office Building (now under construction) when it opens in spring 2020. Until then, the Mid-County Regional Service Office will be temporarily located at 11435 Grandview Ave, Wheaton MD 20902 in the former Fire Station.

Online Resident Survey

County Executive Leggett announced that the County has launched an online survey to gauge residents' assessment of their local government, its services and their quality of life. The 2017 Resident Survey was mailed to 5,000 randomly selected County households in October, and residents who did not receive the questionnaire in the mail are encouraged to participate online.
