The Greater Olney Civic Association (GOCA) represents over 35 homeowner and civic associations in the Olney Master Plan area. For over 30 years, GOCA has promoted the civic, cultural, and economic welfare of the Olney community.

As the Current President of GOCA, I am writing to express our full support of the Maryland-National Capital Parks and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) Montgomery Parks proposal to construct the North Branch Hiker-Biker Trail.

With the construction of this trail, this project will provide a critical segment linking the regional park trail system from the District of Columbia northward to the Route 200 bikeway and through Rock Creek.
